- Develop psychosocial groups and programs to meet the needs of Karuna patients and families.
- Demonstrate proactive and effective communication with other Karuna health professionals to ensure delivery of multidisciplinary patient care.
- Develop positive and productive collaborative working relationships with external health professionals to ensure delivery of high-quality care.
- Ensure patients and other staff are treated fairly and with mutual respect and understanding, regardless of cultural, religious, ethnic, and linguistic backgrounds.
- Maintain accurate and confidential electronic records, reports, and other documentation in accordance with medico legal and health service requirements.
- Fulfill other duties and activities as approved by the FSTL, Community Services Manager or CEO

Selection Criteria

- Minimum of five years post-graduate clinical experience
- Previous experience working in palliative care preferred
- Demonstrated high level of knowledge, expertise and skill in the delivery of community based social work services to patients and their families / carers.
- Demonstrated counselling experience and skills relevant to coping with illness, disability, and grief and bereavement support.
- Demonstrated high level of interpersonal and communication skills with an ability to negotiate, manage conflict and consult effectively with key stakeholders to achieve quality outcomes for the patient group as well as an ability to provide high-level clinical advice to staff regarding social work service delivery.

- Demonstrated experience in participation of the delivery of community programs that enhance patient's and family's quality of life.
- Strong organisational and time management skills with high attention to detail.
